## **Survey Analysis**

Based on the responses, several conclusions can be drawn:

**International Contacts:** Many participants emphasized the establishment of new international connections as a key success of the project. This theme recurs in the responses.

**Cultural Awareness:** Understanding various cultures, their diversity, and the possibilities for collaboration is another recurring theme.

**Collaboration and Teaching Methods:** Responses suggest that the exchange of experiences in teaching methods was highly valued. Incorporating new methods into the educational program is also a common point.

**Poland's Role:** Poland's leadership in the project was particularly appreciated, indicating that the project was perceived as successful in terms of organization and management.

### **Conclusions:**

Recurring themes suggest that the project had the most significant impact in the following areas:

- Strengthening international cooperation,
- Promoting cultural diversity,
- Developing educational methods and sharing experiences.

Based on participants' answers to the question "What could be improved in future projects?", the following conclusions can be drawn:

### **Recurring Themes:**

#### **Teacher Funding:**

Participants highlighted the need for better financial support for teachers involved in the project, emphasizing the importance of budgetary issues and compensation.

#### **Greater Student Involvement:**

Suggestions for including student groups in mobility activities show that participants value active youth participation.

#### **Expanding International Cooperation:**

Proposals to include more countries in future projects suggest that participants appreciate cultural diversity and broader collaboration opportunities.

**Sustainability of Project Results:**

Several individuals noted that implementing the project's results in schools is crucial and requires further improvement.

**Increased Opportunities for Teacher Collaboration:**

There is a suggestion for teachers to have more opportunities to share experiences and develop projects together.

**Key Conclusions:**

Projects like this should address both the financial and organizational needs of teachers and participants.

In the future, focus should be placed on increasing student integration and expanding international cooperation.

The implementation of project results in local schools should be more systematic.

**Acknowledgements and Recognition:**

Many people expressed gratitude to their colleagues, organizers, and everyone involved in the project, reflecting positive feelings and appreciation for teamwork.

**Personal Satisfaction:**

There were comments indicating happiness about participating in the project and positive personal experiences.

**Key Conclusions:**

Participants highly value the organization of the project and the team's dedication.

The project significantly influenced the building of positive relationships and a spirit of cooperation.

Comments reflect a high level of satisfaction and gratitude for the opportunity to participate in such an initiative.
